Please modify applicability condition b to ensure that any type of hydrological manipulation or change is not prohibited.	Changed to: – "... intentional manipulation of the water table is not allowed (i.e. the project activity does not involve manipulation of hydrology or otherwise affect hydrology) ..."
Please add language to ensure that species planted will not cause water table changes (e.g., water hogging species with high evapotranspiration rates).	Language added to restrict application on wetlands where species planted have occurred under historic natural forest conditions within project area per best available knowledge (literature, consultation with local experts and land managers).
